



Professional Development Opportunity: Presence Under Pressure

DHS is sharing a post-Capstone executive development opportunity specifically designed to meet the needs of DHS Executives and Managers who are leading in today's high-visibility, high-impact environment. DHS wants to support senior leaders in having the preparation they need to successfully and strategically lead in dynamic circumstances where media and congressional relations play such a big role in delivering on mission. DHS has worked with the Partnership for Public Service (PPS), who has designed an executive-level 3 ½ day course called *Presence Under Pressure* focused on media training, working effectively with Congress and driving results. The course is tailored for Senior Executives and Managers (non-executive Second-Level Supervisors), and will go beyond the traditional classroom instruction to include personalized media relations training on camera, that can be used to benefit executive acumen under many circumstances.

DHS is pleased that PPS has offered a course session exclusively for DHS Capstone graduates, from June 12-15.
