



Coast Guard Procures Five HC-130J Engines

The Coast Guard procured five Rolls Royce engines, worth approximately \$16 million total, for its HC-130J Super Hercules long range surveillance aircraft as part of a 10-engine buy executed by the Air Force March 13, 2017. The engines are scheduled for delivery to Base Elizabeth City, North Carolina, in summer 2018.
