

Major Maintenance and Repair at Neah Bay Housing



- Civil Engineering Unit Oakland is conducting major renovations on 11 of the 13 family housing units located at Station Neah Bay in Neah Bay, Washington.
- These houses are critical to operations as there is no commercially available housing that meets Coast Guard needs within a one-hour commute the station.
- As part of this project, CEUO is upgrading the outdated electrical and water infrastructure, as well as the fiber optic service to all units.
- These units were built over several decades, with the oldest constructed in the 1960s and the newest in the 1990s. They will undergo complete lead and asbestos abatement, as well as seismic retrofitting to bring them up to code.
- These units will be fully remodeled and are projected to be ready for occupancy by Coast Guard families in mid-to-late-2026.
