Communications shall be sent via email as a command-endorsed, electronically signed memo to HQS-SMB-CG PSC-RPM-BoardsPanels@uscg.mil to arrive no later than the day before the panel convenes. Early communication submissions are required to allow adequate time for correction should a submission contain unauthorized content.

5. All SCPOs being considered shall review their Coast Guard Military Human Resource Record (CGMHRR) in accordance with Ref E. Members names will be removed from the 2023 RMCAP list if advanced prior to the release date of the 2023 RMCAP panel results message. Members must maintain advancement eligibility from the date of recommendation through the date of actual advancement. Members who do not maintain advancement eligibility will be removed from any active advancement eligibility list and must screen again through a subsequent RMCAP review panel.
