

Captain Anthony W. Williams **Chief, Military Personnel Policy (CG-133)**

Captain Anthony Williams assumed the duties as Chief, Office of Military Personnel Policy at Coast Guard Headquarters in Washington D.C. His office provides policy and programmatic support to Coast Guard active duty, reserve, and retired members.

Captain Williams previous operational tours include seven afloat units, four of which he served as Commanding Officer: USCGC MIDGETT (Pre-Commissioning Detachment) in Hawaii, USCGC SPENCER in Massachusetts, USCGC AQUIDNECK in the Middle East, and USCGC BLOCK ISLAND in North Carolina. He also served as Executive Officer of the USCGC ALEX HALEY and two tours on USCGC ACUSHNET (first as a Deck Watch Officer and then as Operations Officer). He served as Officer-in-Charge of a Law Enforcement Detachment for the Coast Guard's Tactical Law Enforcement Team South and as Officer-in-Charge of the Deployable Pursuit Boat detachment in Miami, FL.



Ashore Captain Williams served as the Coast Guard Office of Law Enforcement's liaison to DHS Headquarters and four years on the Coast Guard's Pacific Area staff, the last two years he served as the Chief of Cutter Forces. Captain Williams also served as the Coast Guard's liaison to the U.S. Navy's Office of Surface Warfare (OPNAV N96) at the Pentagon.

Captain Williams holds a Master of Science degree in Quality Systems Management and a Six Sigma Green Belt certification from the National Graduate School. He also holds a Master of Arts degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Naval War College.

Captain Williams has earned the permanent Cutterman Insignia and Tactical Law Enforcement Insignia. His awards include six Meritorious Service Medals, four Commendation Medals, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, and the Iraq Campaign Medal, along with other team awards. Captain Williams is a native of Fairfax, Virginia. He graduated from the Naval Academy Prep School in 1992 and the United States Coast Guard Academy in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Government.
