JANUARY 15	Distribute FPCAs to eligible voters	Deadline for VAOs to distribute FPCAs to all eligible Voters. Completed Forms should be sent to the voters local election official, and allow members to register or update their absentee mailing address. JANUARY 26	Voting Assistance Officer Workshops	DoD Instruction 1000.04 requires all VAOs to complete either an FVAP/Service-provided workshop or online training. Find workshop and training opportunities at http://www.fvap.gov/vao/training .		
FEBRUARY 7	Super Bowl Challenge	FVAP will be airing public service announcements during the Super Bowl on AFN. VAO's should consider hosting Voter Registration Drives and advertisements around their Unit Super Bowl Party. Send photos to the SVAO.		
MARCH 31	Measures of Effect and Performance	Deadline for VAOs, Installation Voter Assistance Offices and Recruiting Offices to submit metrics covering the period from 1 January - 31 March in the FVAP Admin Portal.

JUNE 27	Armed Forces Voters Week & Overseas Citizens Voters Week	VAOs should plan & participate in Voting Emphasis Week (June 27-July 5, 2016) activities to encourage eligible citizens to apply to register to vote and request an absentee ballot. VAOs should plan events around their Unit 4th of July activities.		

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JUNE 30	Measures of Effect and Performance	Deadline for VAOs, Installation Voter Assistance Offices and Recruiting Offices to submit metrics covering the period from 1 April - 30 June in the FVAP Admin Portal.
JULY 15	Distribute FPCAs to UOCAVA voters	Deadline for VAOs to distribute the FPCA(electronically or in hand) to UOCAVA voters they assist and encourage them to complete and submit to their local election official to apply to register and/or request an absentee ballot for the 2016 General Election.
AUGUST 1	Recommended Voting Assistance Officer Training Day	Voter Assistance Officers and their office personnel who assist voters should complete the appropriate training course as an Installation VAO or Unit VAO. Find workshop and training information at http://www.fvap.gov/vao/training.
SEPTEMBER 24	Absentee Ballot Mailing by States	Voters should begin checking their mail and email for their ballot. Everyone should be encouraged to Vote and return their ballot upon receiving it!
SEPTEMBER 26	Absentee Voting Week	VAOs should encourage all absentee voters to complete and return their absentee ballot. Absentee Voting Week runs from September 26 - October 3, 2016.
SEPTEMBER 30	Measures of Effect and Performance	Deadline for VAOs, Installation Voter Assistance Offices and Recruiting Offices to submit metrics covering the period from 1 July - 30 September in the FVAP Admin Portal.
OCTOBER 25	Overseas Recommended Mailing Date	Voters at overseas military installations and on ships at sea should send voted ballots in so they arrive in time to be counted.
NOVEMBER 1	Stateside Recommended Mailing Date	Uniformed Service members and their families at stateside military installations should send voted ballots in now so they arrive in time to be counted.
NOVEMBER 8	Election Day	VAOs should remind local voters to go to their polling place and vote. IVA Officers should ensure office coverage to answer last minute questions and assist voters returning their ballots by fax or mail.

Check-Ins	VAOs should provide an opportunity for all voters to complete an FPCA to update their address for their local election official to ensure proper mailing ovoting materials. VAO's should be on the unit's check-in sheet to ensure this opportunity is provided to all personnel during their check-in at a new unit.			
Directory Information The Major Command and Installation Voting Assistance Officers must maintain a directory of all subordinate VAOs email addresses and office telephone numbers. This directory must be updated at least quarterly.				
Website Information	Provide the current contact information of Voting Assistance Officers/Offices on the organization's website.			
Public Affairs	VAOs must work with PAO to publicize any special elections or ballot measures, and inform military personnel and their family members of their right to vote. Voting outreach efforts should be incorporated into military and family appreciation events, and pre-deployment briefs.
