A. Memorandum of Agreement between United States Coast Guard and United States Navy Bureau of Medicine and Surgery Regarding Professional Exchange and Consultation Between Coast Guard Medical Officers and Navy Undersea Medical Officers As It Pertains to Joint Service Warfighter Readiness and Homeland Security

1. On 31 October 2017, Reference (A) became effective.
2. Reference (A) defines the terms by which Navy Medicine shall assist US Coast Guard (USCG) Medical Officers in dive medicine consultation. This will enable USCG to ensure medically qualified personnel are available to fulfill assigned diving duties as outlined in paragraphs 2(a) – 2(d) of Reference (A).
