A. ALCOAST 177/18, Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) Immunization Requirements

- B. COMDT (CG-112) OIX 15 May 18, Measles/Rubella Vaccination Compliance
- C. Immunizations and Chemoprophylaxis for the Prevention of Infectious Diseases, COMDTINST M6230.4G
- 1. In May 2018, REFs (A) and (B) were released with the intent of bringing all Coast Guard (CG) personnel into compliance with the

measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccination requirements found in REF (C).

2. As a reminder, in order to be considered medically ready, all CG personnel born after 31 Dec 1957 must have documented in the

Medical Readiness Reporting System (MRRS) either two lifetime doses of MMR vaccine or positive antibody titers to measles and rubella.

- 3. Personnel who do not meet the requirement must either provide evidence of a second MMR shot (if they have evidence of only one)
- or must receive a second MMR shot. Drawing measles and/or rubella titers solely for the purpose of compliance with this OIX is not authorized, new accessions excepted.
- 4. On or about 1 May 2019, MRRS will be updated such that personnel not in compliance with the MMR vaccination requirement will show

red for vaccinations in Coast Guard Business Intelligence.
