SUBJ: DELETION OF IPECAC SYRUP FROM HEALTH SERVICES ALLOWANCE LISTS AND FORMULARY REQUIREMENTS

- A. STANDARDIZED HEALTH SERVICES TECHNICIAN DRUG FORMULARY, COMDTINST 6570.1 (SERIES)
- B. HEALTH SERVICES ALLOWANCE LIST, PART III (SHORE UNITS AND VESSELS) COMDTINST M6700.7 (SERIES)
- 1. THE NON PRESCRIPTION DRUG ADVISORY PANEL OF THE FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION (FDA) RECOMMENDED IN 2003 THAT IPECAC SYRUP BE REMOVED FROM OVER-THE-COUNTER (OTC) STATUS. RESEARCH HAS FOUND THAT THERE IS NO CLEAR, CONSISTENT EVIDENCE THAT IPECAC SYRUP IS HELPFUL THERAPEUTICALLY AFTER A POISONOUS INGESTION. EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS HAVE DISCONTINUED THE USE OF IPECAC SYRUP IN FAVOR OF ACTIVATED CHARCOAL.
- 2. THE ACQUISITION OF IPECAC SYRUP HAS BECOME INCREASINGLY MORE DIFFICULT TO OBTAIN.
- 3. COAST GUARD CLINICS AND INDEPENDENT DUTY HEALTH SERVICES TECHNICIANS SHALL NO LONGER BE REQUIRED TO STOCK IPECAC SYRUP AS PART OF THE REQUIRED MEDICATION AND ANTIDOTE STOCKING GUIDELINES (REFERENCES A AND B).
