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SUBJ: ELECTRONIC PRIVILEGING FOR ALL HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

A. MEDICAL MANUAL, COMDTINST M6000.1 (SERIES)

1. THIS MESSAGE PROVIDES GUIDANCE TO THE PROCESS OF ELECTRONIC PRIVILEGING FOR ALL HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS PROVIDING SERVICES TO PATIENTS IN THE COAST GUARD HEALTH SYSTEM. HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS SUBJECT TO PRIVILEGING REQUIREMENTS ARE OUTLINED IN REF (A). THE ELECTRONIC PRIVILEGING PROCESS IS STARTED 90 DAYS FROM EXPIRATION OF CURRENT PRIVILEGES. ELECTRONIC PRIVILEGING MUST ALSO BE UTILIZED WHEN ADDING OR TRANSFERRING A SUPPLEMENTAL SCOPE OF PRACTICE.
2. UPON PERMANENT CHANGE OF STATION (PCS) CORE PRIVILEGES WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT. PRIOR TO EXPIRATION AN EMAIL WILL BE SENT TO THE PROVIDER VIA THEIR COAST GUARD GLOBAL ACCOUNT WITH INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO ESTABLISH A CENTRALIZED CREDENTIALING QUALITY ASSURANCE SYSTEM (CCQAS) ACCOUNT AND THE STEPS NECESSARY FOR COMPLETING THE ELECTRONIC APPLICATION. IN ADDITION TO EMAIL GUIDANCE, THERE IS A SAMPLE REQUEST FOR CLINICAL PRIVILEGES AVAILABLE AT [HTTP://WWW.USCG.MIL/HQ/CG1/CG112/CG1122](http://www.uscg.mil/hq/cg1/cg112/cg1122) UNDER EACH OF THE PROVIDER TYPES. THE SAMPLE REQUEST FOR CLINICAL PRIVILEGES AND THE DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS SHOULD BE FOLLOWED AS PROVIDED ON THE CG-1122 WEBSITE.
3. UPON PCS SUPPLEMENTAL PRIVILEGES MUST BE RENEWED. PROVIDERS SHOULD EMAIL MARYANN.MILLETT(AT)USCG.MIL REQUESTING A NEW APPLICATION. THE REQUESTED SUPPLEMENTAL PRIVILEGES WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER REVIEWING SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION THAT DETAILS THE PROVIDERS KNOWLEDGE, SKILL, EDUCATION, AND PROFICIENCY. IN CASES WHERE THE SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST CANNOT BE SUPPORTED THE E-APPLICATION WILL BE FORWARDED WITH A NON-SUPPORT RECOMMENDATION. THIS ACTION WILL NOT REFLECT NEGATIVELY ON THE PROVIDER AND IS A NON-REPORTABLE ACTION.
