SUBJ: INTERIM GUIDANCE FOR NON-MEDICAL PERSONNEL ACCESS TO CG MEDICAL INFORMATION SYSTEMS A. COAST GUARD MEDICAL MANUAL, COMDTINST M6000.1E 1. DUE TO THE INCREASED LEVEL OF DOD COMPUTER SECURITY MEASURES AND THE UPCOMING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW CG ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD (CG-EHR), CG-112 PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING INTERIM GUIDANCE FOR NON-RATES AND NON-MEDICAL TAD PERSONNEL ACCESS TO CG MEDICAL INFORMATION SYSTEM (MIS).

2. NON-RATES WHO REQUIRE ACCESS TO CG MIS AND ARE CURRENTLY ON THE HS A SCHOOL WAITING LIST, ARE THE ONLY NON-MEDICAL PERSONS AUTHORIZED ACCESS TO CG MIS.
3. ALL OTHER NON-RATES AND NON-MEDICAL TAD PERSONNEL ARE NOT AUTHORIZED ACCESS TO CG MIS. IF THESE MEMBERS CURRENTLY HAVE ACCESS TO CG MIS, DEACTIVATE THEIR ACCOUNTS IMMEDIATELY.
4. THIS DOES NOT PRECLUDE NON-RATES OR NON-MEDICAL TAD PERSONNEL FROM BEING ASSIGNED OTHER DUTIES IN THE CLINICS. CLINIC ADMINISTRATORS SHOULD ENSURE THAT ALL NON-MEDICAL PERSONNEL WORKING IN THE CLINIC ADHERE TO THE GUIDELINES SET FORTH IN REF A.
