SEEKING POSTGRADUATE TRAINING AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT A SERVICE OBLIGATION OF
THREE YEARS IAW REF (B) WILL BE INCURRED AS WELL AS A FOLLOW-ON
UTILIZATION TOUR AS DETERMINED BY PSC-OPM.
