B. COAST GUARD MEDICAL MANUAL, COMDTINST M6000.1 (SERIES) 1. IAW REF (A)
AND (B) THIS MESSAGE ESTABLISHES A NEW REQUIREMENT FOR ALL COAST GUARD
MEDICAL OFFICERS TO ATTEND THE HAZELDEN AOHCP COURSE.

THIS COURSE TRAINS MEDICAL OFFICERS IN THE LATEST SCIENCE, MEDICAL
EVIDENCE, POLICIES, AND PROCEDURES RELATED TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE SCREENING
AND DIAGNOSIS.

2. EFFECTIVE WITH THIS MESSAGE, THE HAZELDEN AOHCP IS REQUIRED TRAINING TO
CONDUCT SUBSTANCE ABUSE SCREENINGS. ALL COAST GUARD MEDICAL OFFICERS WHO
HAVE NOT TAKEN THE COURSE MUST COMPLETE THE HAZELDEN AOHCP BY 31 DECEMBER
2012.

3. AN ABBREVIATED COURSE WILL BE REQUIRED EVERY SIX YEARS FOR MAINTENANCE
OF COMPETENCIES ONCE ALL REQUIRED MEDICAL OFFICERS HAVE COMPLETED INITIAL
TRAINING EFFECTIVE WITH THE 2010 GRADUATES.

ADDITIONALLY, AN ANNUAL WEB-BASED REFRESHER WILL BE REQUIRED BEGINNING IN
2013. A QUALITY IMPROVEMENT IMPLEMENTATION GUIDE (QIIG) WILL BE ISSUED
THAT DETAILS THE ONGOING REQUIREMENTS.
