ALL COAST GUARD MEDICAL OFFICERS WHO HAVE NOT TAKEN THE COURSE MUST COMPLETE THE HAZELDEN AOHCP BY 31 DECEMBER 2012. 3. AN ABBREVIATED COURSE WILL BE REQUIRED EVERY SIX YEARS FOR MAINTENANCE OF COMPETENCIES ONCE ALL REQUIRED MEDICAL OFFICERS HAVE COMPLETED INITIAL TRAINING EFFECTIVE WITH THE 2010 GRADUATES. ADDITIONALLY, AN ANNUAL WEB-BASED REFRESHER WILL BE REQUIRED BEGINNING IN 2013. A QUALITY IMPROVEMENT IMPLEMENTATION GUIDE (QIIG) WILL BE ISSUED THAT DETAILS THE ONGOING REQUIREMENTS. 4.
