SUBJ: SMALLPOX VACCINATION PROGRAM UPDATE A. COMDTINST M6230.10, Coast Guard Smallpox Vaccine Program (SVP) 1. Coast Guard members who received the smallpox vaccination in 2003 are due for revaccination after 10 years per Reference A.

- 2. Coast Guard members identified in Reference A (excluding those listed in paragraphs 3 and 4) are no longer mandated to receive the smallpox vaccine.
- 3. Deployable Specialized Forces personnel, healthcare personnel, and any personnel deploying to combatant commands requiring smallpox vaccination for entry will continue to receive smallpox vaccination.
- 4. Accessions will continue to receive the smallpox vaccination until Reference A is updated.
- 5. The Coast Guard Business Intelligence (CGBI) system and the Medical Readiness Reporting System will be updated to reflect these changes.
- 6. Reference A will be updated.
