SUBJ: DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENT UPDATE A. COAST GUARD MEDICAL MANUAL, COMDTINST M6000.1 (SERIES) 1. THE COAST GUARD BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE (CGBI) SYSTEM NOW INCLUDES DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENT METRICS BASED ON COAST GUARD MEMBERS PARTICIPATION IN AN EXPEDITIONARY DEPLOYMENT. CGBI DATA IS PULLED FROM THE MEDICAL READINESS AND REPORTING SYSTEM (MRRS), WHICH PULLS FROM THE ELECTRONIC DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENT (EDHA) DATABASE. THESE METRICS WILL DISPLAY RED, AMBER OR GREEN DEPENDING UPON WHETHER A MEMBER IS DELINQUENT, PENDING OR UP-TO-DATE (RESPECTIVELY) WITH THEIR POST-DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENT (PDHA), FORM DD-2796 OR POST-DEPLOYMENT HEALTH REASSESSMENT (PDHRA), FORM DD-2900.

2. A NUMBER OF COAST GUARD MEMBERS ARE DELINQUENT WITH THEIR PDHA, PDHRA, OR BOTH. WITH THIS INITIAL ROLL OUT, THE DEPLOYMENT HEALTH METRIC IN CGBI WILL ONLY BE VIEWABLE AS A CUBE OR REPORT. IT WILL NOT BE VIEWABLE ON THE MEMBERS PERSONAL OR UNIT PAGE SO THEY WILL NOT HAVE VISIBILITY OF THEIR STATUS UNLESS ACTIVELY SEEKING IT AS A CGBI CUBE REPORT. COMMANDS WILL SIMILARLY HAVE TO SEEK OUT THE INFORMATION AT THIS TIME.

3. REGIONAL MANAGERS AND REGIONAL PRACTICE DIRECTORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO REVIEW THEIR SPECIFIC DISTRICT LEVEL DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENT REPORTS IN CGBI TO GAIN OVERSIGHT OF THEIR RESPECTIVE CLINICS.

CLINICS WILL HAVE TO NOTIFY DELINQUENT MEMBERS OF THEIR STATUS AND TAKE ACTION TO COMPLETE THE DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENT PROCESS.

4. EFFECTIVE 1 JULY 2012, THIS METRIC WILL BECOME VISIBLE TO MEMBERS AND COMMANDS ON THE UNIT AND PERSONAL PAGE OF CGBI.

5. CLINICS SHOULD REFER MEMBERS TO CHAPTER 6 OF REFERENCE (A) WHICH DETAILS THE APPROPRIATE STEPS MEMBERS SHOULD TAKE TO COMPLETE THEIR DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENTS VIA THE EDHA DATABASE. CLINICS SHOULD ENSURE THAT ALL MEDICAL OFFICERS HAVE ACCESS TO THE EDHA IN PREPARATION FOR EVALUATING COAST GUARD MEMBERS FOR THEIR DEPLOYMENT HEALTH ASSESSMENTS.
