4. Criteria for each award are as follows:

An active duty licensed and registered a. Coast Guard Pharmacy Officer Award: pharmacist, who has exemplified sustained excellence in leadership and innovation or who has performed a specific act within the last 12 months that has had a significant impact, improving the standards of practice, patient care and outcomes, operational efficiency, or cost-effectiveness of Coast Guard pharmacy operations.

b. Coast Guard Pharmacy Technician Award: An active duty "C" School trained technician currently working at least 50 percent of the time in a Coast Guard pharmacy setting, who has exemplified sustained excellence, or who has performed a specific act within the last 12 months that has positively improved patient care or the practice of Coast Guard pharmacy operations.

5. An awards selection committee will review and evaluate each nominee based on the above criteria and based upon the ments of their individual contributions and

demonstrated commitment to pharmacy excellence.
