

The President's Management Council Interagency Rotation Program

The President's Management Council sponsors an interagency rotation program for high-potential GS 13-15 employees. It enables emerging federal leaders to expand their management skills, broaden their organizational experience, and foster networks they can leverage in the future. Information and requirements for participation about the PMC Interagency Rotation Program may be found on DHS Connect.

We are seeking <u>both</u> participants and program offices based in the Washington, DC Area that can offer challenging and rewarding rotational assignment opportunities. Interested offices should submit a request for consideration. The ideal rotational assignment is one that will stretch and develop these high-potential GS 13-15 employees during the six-month rotation (OCTOBER 1, 2018 – MARCH 29, 2019). Rotational Assignments that require TS/SCI are **not** encouraged.

All applications for both individuals applying to participate, as well as programs desiring to host fellows MUST be routed through CG-128 for review. All applications will be forwarded to the PMC program. There is NO internal CG selection process for this opportunity.

Civilians wishing to apply must complete the <u>Participant Statement of Interest</u> (must have a CAC to access; may require PIN) form located on <u>DHS Connect</u> and return to <u>HQS-SMB-CG-12CTrainingCourses@uscg.mil</u> no later than May 4, 2018.

Offices and supervisors wishing to host a PMC Fellow must submit a PMC Rotation Experience (must have a CAC to access; may require PIN) form and return it to HQS-SMB-CG-
12CTrainingCourses@uscg.mil no later than May 4, 2018.
