Her outstanding performance and positive attitude on and off the court led her to be chosen as starting point guard for the U.S. Armed Forces team at the 2nd Conseil International Du Sport Militaire (CISM) World Military Women's Basketball Championship in San Antonio, TX. This competition was a 5-game series during which a hand-picked group of elite, military basketball players competed against other military teams from around the world. Her play enabled Team USA to earn a Silver medal during the series.

SN Bennett also gave back to her community by dedicating many hours of charity work during her personal time, most notably visiting the Ronald McDonald house in Corpus Christi, TX.
