

# Acquisition Update: Coast Guard Makes \$1.5 Million Order To Expand Implementation Of New Logistics And Maintenance System

The Coast Guard purchased \$1.5 million in new software licenses Nov. 18, 2014, from Mythics Inc. that will allow the service to expand its use of new logistics and maintenance software in support of its aircraft and boats.

The Coast Guard began implementing the Logistics Information Management System as the primary maintenance software across the HC-144A Ocean Sentry aircraft fleet on Dec. 6, 2014, and will complete that process by the end of 2015. The service will use the new licenses to expand CG-LIMS support to all of its aircraft and some of its boats by the end of 2018.

Mythics provides the Oracle e-business software upon which CG-LIMS is based and other software components that add capabilities to the system, such as the Complex Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul component.

Future versions of CG-LIMS will include supply chain and financial management. They will also add software to manage depot-level maintenance and libraries for engineering manuals and technical drawings.
