

Coast Guard To Hold C-27J Programmed Depot Maintenance Industry Day

The Coast Guard HC-27J Asset Project Office is hosting a C-27J Programmed Depot Maintenance Industry Day July 14-15, 2015, at the Elizabeth City State University Fine Arts Center in Elizabeth City, North Carolina. Preregistration is required by noon July 8.

The event is being held in conjunction with a request for information to assist the Coast Guard in determining potential sources for C-27J PDM support.

Capt. Shannon McCullar, HC-27J APO commanding officer, will open the event on July 14. The agenda includes an overview of

programmed depot maintenance and depot-level maintenance procedure cards, tours of the C-27J and APO, vendor questions and networking. Sessions run from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Vendors also can request one-on-one meetings with the contracting officer and technical experts on July 15.

The Coast Guard is using the Industry Day and RFI to inform future efforts to obtain capabilities, technical assistance and facilities to support PDM and major repair and modification of its C-27J aircraft, with an emphasis on the airframe structure and aircraft systems that require depot level repair and/or overhaul. Regular PDM will ensure that the Coast Guard has the necessary HC-27J aircraft available to fulfill its operational needs.
