The Coast Guard HC-27J Asset Project Office in Elizabeth City, North Carolina, received the service's fourth C-27J Oct. 9. Successful flight tests culminated the aircraft's regeneration process at the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group's facility in Tucson, Arizona.
