The Coast Guard began renovation work to extend the service life of the 140-foot icebreaking tug Penobscot Bay at the Coast Guard Yard in Curtis Bay, Maryland, Feb. 2, 2015. Penobscot Bay is the second icebreaking tug to undergo a service life extension project as part of the In-Service Vessel Sustainment program.
