

Eighth C-27J Spartan Completes Regeneration

The Coast Guard HC-27J Asset Project Office in Elizabeth City, North Carolina, received the service's eighth regenerated C-27J Spartan medium range surveillance aircraft Aug. 25, 2016. Regeneration is the process of inspecting, verifying and repairing the aircraft to clear it for flight and is completed by the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group on Davis-Monthan Air Force Base in Tucson, Arizona.
