

Seventh C-27J Spartan Completes Regeneration

The Coast Guard HC-27J Asset Project Office in Elizabeth City, North Carolina, received the service's seventh regenerated C-27J Spartan medium range surveillance aircraft June 17, 2016. Regeneration involves inspecting, verifying and repairing the aircraft before certifying it as airworthy and is completed by the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group on Davis-Monthan Air Force Base in Tucson, Arizona.
