

Coast Guard Accepts Ninth C-27J Spartan

The Coast Guard accepted the service's ninth regenerated C-27J Spartan medium range surveillance aircraft Sept. 29, 2016. The aircraft was flown to the Leading Edge Aviation Services paint facility in Fort Worth, Texas, Sept. 30, following the regeneration process at the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group on Davis-Monthan Air Force Base in Tucson, Arizona. The Coast Guard will regenerate 13 C-27Js through this process, which involves inspection, verification and repair.
