



MH-60T Upgrade Program Transitions To Sustainment

The Coast Guard formally transitioned responsibility for its MH-60T Jayhawk medium range recovery helicopters to the sustainment community for operations and support Nov. 29, 2016. The acquisition program to upgrade the helicopters from HH-60Js to MH-60Ts began in 2002 and added new avionics architecture, flight instruments, and communications and navigation equipment across the 45-helicopter fleet.
