

CEU Oakland Recapitalizes Aviation Apron at Air Station Astoria



- CEU Oakland is nearing completion of a \$4.2 million project to repair and resurface over 200,000 square feet of concrete on Air Station Astoria's aviation apron, located in Astoria, Oregon.
- Air Station Astoria provides critical aviation support for Search and Rescue, Drug Interdiction, Defense Readiness, and Maritime Environmental Protection missions along the Pacific Northwest coastline and Columbia River system.
- This project recapitalized the aging and damaged apron using state-of-the-art Polyester Polymer Concrete (PPC) overlay, which enhances the structural integrity and longevity of the concrete apron by providing a durable and protective layer over the existing surface.
