

Coast Guard Sells Excess Jonesport Housing — Nets \$1.175 million for CG Housing Fund!



- Approved for divestiture in December 2022, the excess housing in Jonesport, Maine was sold at auction for the sum total of \$1,175,000, which was nearly \$175,000 over the appraised value. The sale closed on August 5, 2025.
- The property included nine single family homes on 10 acres. Acquired in October 1967 for the nominal amount of \$1, this was as a critical housing site for Coast Guard families for nearly 50 years until new family housing was constructed by the Facilities Design and Construction Center (FDCC).
- The divestiture process was executed by the Shore Infrastructure Logistics Center (SILC) Real Property Branch and Civil Engineering Unit (CEU) Providence through a collaborative effort involving the General Services Administration (GSA).
- All proceeds from the sale will be retained for future construction or acquisition of family and unaccompanied personnel housing projects.
