CDR Platt is currently the Executive Officer of Coast Guard Base Alameda, responsible for mission support activities that support Coast Guard operations of PACAREA, the Eleventh Coast Guard District, and its subordinate commands. Base Alameda serves as the host command for 19 tenant commands on Coast Guard Island.

Prior to her current assignment she served as Logistics Department Head at Coast Guard Recruiting Command in Washington DC. There she supervised the contracting, finance, security, IT, leasing, and Admin branches that support the Coast Guard's 56 recruiting offices nationwide.

Previous assignments include Logistics Department Head and CPFR Chief at Sector Buffalo, NY, DHS Planner at District 13 in Seattle, WA, Logistics Department Head and Marine Inspections at Sector Portland, OR, Admissions Officer at the Coast Guard Academy, and Deck Watch Officer aboard the CGC VIGOROUS in Cape May, NJ.
