Master Chief Chris Fly assumed the duties and responsibilities as the Command Master Chief for Base Alameda, CA on July 2nd, 2021 after serving as the CMC for the Maritime Force Protection Unit Bangor, WA since 2018.

Master Chief Fly is a native of Indianapolis, Indiana. He enlisted in the U.S. Coast Guard in September 1993. After completing Basic Recruit Training at TRACEN Cape May, NJ, he was assigned to COMMSTA New Orleans, LA. Master Chief Fly completed Electronics Technician "A" School in September 1995 with a followon tour on CGC TAMPA (WMEC 902) in Portsmouth, VA. After a



change in rating, he attended Health Services Technician "A" School in September 1999.
