Master Chief Jason Bryant recently served as the Cyber Training & School Chief for the Office of Cyber Forces (CG-791), where he directed the professional development and readiness of the Coast Guard's cyber workforce. Previously, he served as the Senior Enlisted Leader for the 2013 Cyber Protection Team.

A native of St. Petersburg, Florida, Master Chief Bryant enlisted in 2002. His distinguished career spans numerous operational and leadership roles, including Command Center Supervisor at Sector Honolulu, Operations Chief for Deployable Communications Force East, and underway assignments aboard USCGC SENECA and USS SULLIVANS. He also spent 22 months deployed to Sierra Leone and Cape Verde developing counter-piracy operations centers. Master Chief Bryant holds elite qualifications as the eighth enlisted Search & Rescue Mission Coordinator and the fourth National Incident Management Communications Leader Type 1 in the Coast Guard.

A graduate of the Coast Guard Senior Enlisted Course and Chief Petty Officer's Academy Class 216, he holds an A.S. in Business Administration and is completing a B.S. in Applied Cybersecurity from the SANS Institute. His personal decorations include the Coast Guard Meritorious Service Medal, seven Coast Guard Commendation Medals, and the Army Achievement Medal. He is also the recipient of the 2022 Captain Niels P. Thomsen Innovation Award, the 2019 DHS Secretary's Award for Unity of Effort, and wears the Operations Response Ashore and Boat Forces Operations Insignia.
