



Captain Graham was most recently assigned to Coast Guard Cyber Command's Detachment to US Cyber Command. In this assignment, he served as Chief of the Detachment and simultaneously in the role of Executive Officer of the Cyber National Mission Force (CNMF).

From 2021-2024, he served as the Executive Officer of CG Base Miami Beach, which provided mission support functions to the CG units and personnel throughout the CG's Southeast District as well as contingency logistics for Hurricane Ian, Operation Vigilant Sentry, Operation Southeast Watch and other significant events. Additional previous assignments include, Communications & Security Department Head at the Coast Guard's Southwest District. In that capacity he provided policy oversight on all Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Cyber, and Intel system (C5I) matters impacting the operational CG units across the District. While assigned here, he was the chair of the Communications Work Group for North American Maritime Security Initiative (NAMSII). Additionally, he served as the Chief of Logistics at Sector Maryland-National Capital Region (NCR). During this period, he filled the role of Logistics Section Chief at the Incident Command Post providing maritime security for the 2017 Presidential Inauguration. He was the Operations Officer at Electronic Support Unit Alameda, Supervisor at Electronic Systems Support Detachment Alameda, and Branch Chief at the Command, Control, and Communications Engineering Center (C3CEN). He also completed a tour aboard USCGC CHASE, homeported in San Diego, CA.

CAPT Graham is a proud member of the U.S. Coast Guard Academy class of 2004, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering. He earned a Master's of Science in Electrical Engineering from the University of Virginia in 2008.
