Captain Jackie Leverich returns to Base Alameda having previously served as the Planning and Force Readiness Division Chief for Coast Guard District Eleven where she led real-time contingency response during the historic 2020 Wildfire Season, the largest in California history since state-record-keeping began in 1932, and national pandemic planning efforts across the Pacific Area and District Eleven Area of Responsibility as Incident Commander for the PACAREA Mission Support COVID Action Team.

Previous tours of duty include Deck Watch Officer and Weapons Officer on USCGC MORGENTHAU, Executive Officer on USCGC WASHINGTON, District Fourteen Chief of Public Affairs, Leadership and Organizational Performance School Chief and Instructor at the Leadership Development Center, Logistics Department Head at Sector Boston and Section Chief for the Coast Guard Force Readiness Command Finance and Administration Assessment Team and Food Service Assistance and Training Team. As Personnel Service Center's Surge Staffing Branch Chief, she was responsible for all short-term contingency and surge staffing across the service and managed the mobilization of thousands of personnel in response to the historic 2017 Hurricane Season. Captain Leverich also previously served as Base Alameda's Executive Officer where she oversaw delivery of mission support to 19 tenant commands, 6,000 people, four Sectors, two Air Stations and four National Security Cutters across District Eleven.

Captain Leverich is a native of Greendale, Wisconsin and a 1997 graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree in Government. She also received a Master of Arts in Organizational Change and a graduate certificate in Global Leadership from Hawaii Pacific University in 2006.

Captain Leverich's military decorations include five Meritorious Service Medals, three Commendation Medals and two Achievement Medals with "O" device. She earned permanent cutterman status in 2004.

Captain Leverich currently resides in Alameda, CA with her husband Kris, who is a recently retired Lieutenant Commander. In her free time she paddles outrigger canoe and rows whaleboat with local teams and enjoys exploring San Francisco Bay in their 38' Chris Craft.
