



CDR Lisa M. Sharkey received a direct-commission in 2004. She graduated Coast Guard Boot Camp Cape May, NJ in 1987. Her first assignments were District 7 in Miami, FL with a short tour on the CGC Shearwater (surface effect ship) homeported in Key West, FL. In 1990 she received orders to Aviation Structural Mechanic "A" school at Aviation Technical Training Center in Elizabeth City, NC where upon graduation she was assigned to Air Station Miami, FL. Her aviation qualifications include Aircrew and Dropmaster in the HU-25 – Falcon Jet and Sensor Operator in the RG-8. While enlisted in aviation, she earned the FAA Airframe and Power-plant licenses and completed Associates of Science in Aviation Maintenance Management from Broward Community College. She was selected for direct commission engineer in 2003 and

promoted from Petty Officer First Class to Ensign in January 2004.
