Purpose: The focus of this workshop will be to assist members and their families who will be executing a PCS transfer, retiring, or separating from the service in calendar year 2018. During this workshop you will complete your HHGs shipment setup in

Note: Attendees MUST bring a copy of their orders to the workshop. If you do not have a copy of your approved/ready to execute orders, please contact your unit admin to obtain a copy. Prior to attending the workshop, members must also obtain a user name and password from Move.mil where job aids and other useful informational links are available. Please note - overseas entry approval is required for all overseas shipments outside the continental U.S. (OCONUS).

We have 10 reservations available for each class. Spouses are encouraged to attend. Unfortunately, no childcare services are available. All HHG shipments to and from Hampton Roads, the Eastern Shore, and Northeastern North Carolina are booked through a single scheduling point and this creates a high volume of shipments that are required to be scheduled in this area. Therefore, please maximize flexibility when considering your HHGs pick-up and/or delivery date(s).

Members who choose to complete a full or partial personally procured move (PPM) (formerly known as a Do It Yourself Move/DITY) should also attend.
