

For proper disposal of paints, polishes, stains, yard chemicals (i.e. pesticides), cleaners, photo chemicals, auto fluids (i.e. waste oil & brake fluid), auto/marine batteries, light bulbs & mercury containing devices (CFL bulbs, thermometers, etc.)

#### **RECYCLABLE ITEMS**

The Recycling Center accepts the following recyclable items that can be dropped off during hours of operation or by appointment:

-PLASTICS -PAPER -GLASS -DRY CARDBOARD (flattened) -TIRES (no rims) -METAL (cans, etc.) -APPLIANCES -ELECTRONICS (e-waste) -BATTERIES & BULBS -CONSTRUCTION AND RESIDENTIAL DEMOLITION ITEMS

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Offs are planned during scheduled basewide clean up weeks. These dates will be advertised in base notifications distributed by the USCG Housing Office to base residents and staff.
