Code of Massachusetts Regulation 310 CMR 19.00 REQUIRES that ALL recyclable materials be diverted from general trash collection and construction & demo-lition debris while being deposited in an appropriate recycling stream within a designated recycling area.



RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

Single Stream Materials - all paper fibers, plastics, glass, and cans.

Metal - all metal with the exception of LEAD is collected at the recycling center specific containers.

Electronic Components- Any material that contains a printed circuit board or cathode ray tubes (CRT) which are typically found in monitors, TV's, as well as power cords and cables.

Universal Waste Material - All batteries, High Intensity Bulbs (HID) and metal halide bulbs. All mercury containing equipment or devices such as thermostats and florescent bulbs.

Textiles - A drop box is located in the Base Exchange parking lot for clothes, shoes, accessories, linens, and stuffed animals.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Disposal is conducted during scheduled CapeCodextension.org events which are locally held throughout Cape Cod and can be viewed at <https://www.capecodextension.org/hazardouswaste/hhw/>. Please do not conceal HHW in regular trash or leave these items at curbside. If you have HHW that you need to dispose of outside of these scheduled events due to unforeseen circumstances, please contact Environmental Health and Safety at the above listed numbers.

Residents are not authorized to leave furniture/mattress/trash/etc. outside of any dumpsters.
Dispose of oversized items at the Recycling Center during normal operating hours or make an appointment with Center staff.
