### Team Kodiak Afloat XO's, Supervisors, and Chiefs:

### **If a member is arriving to Kodiak from Out of State Travel:**

1. Members arriving to Kodiak shall follow State of Alaska guidelines found here: <https://covid19.alaska.gov/travelers/>
2. In the event pre-deployment ROM assistance is needed from Base Kodiak, units should send an email to [D17-DG-M-K-BaseKodiak-COVID19-QuarantineCare@uscg.mil](mailto:D17-DG-M-K-BaseKodiak-COVID19-QuarantineCare@uscg.mil)

3. To avoid negative impact to operations, ensure lodging arrangements are made well in advance of arrival.
4. Read and become familiar with Base Kodiak's *Post Arrival* .pdf located on [Base Kodiak COVID-19 Information](#) website.
5. Commands, supervisors, and sponsors must track member arrivals and ensure quarantine/ROM plans are followed.
6. Communicate with Base Kodiak Quarantine Care and Base Kodiak Medical, early and often.

### Base Kodiak Risk Mitigation

**GREEN or LOW RISK** - No or low level community Transmission in Kodiak.

**AMBER or MEDIUM RISK** - Moderate Transmission Risk in Kodiak.

**RED or HIGH RISK** - Community Transmission on Base Kodiak.

### ***New for 2021***

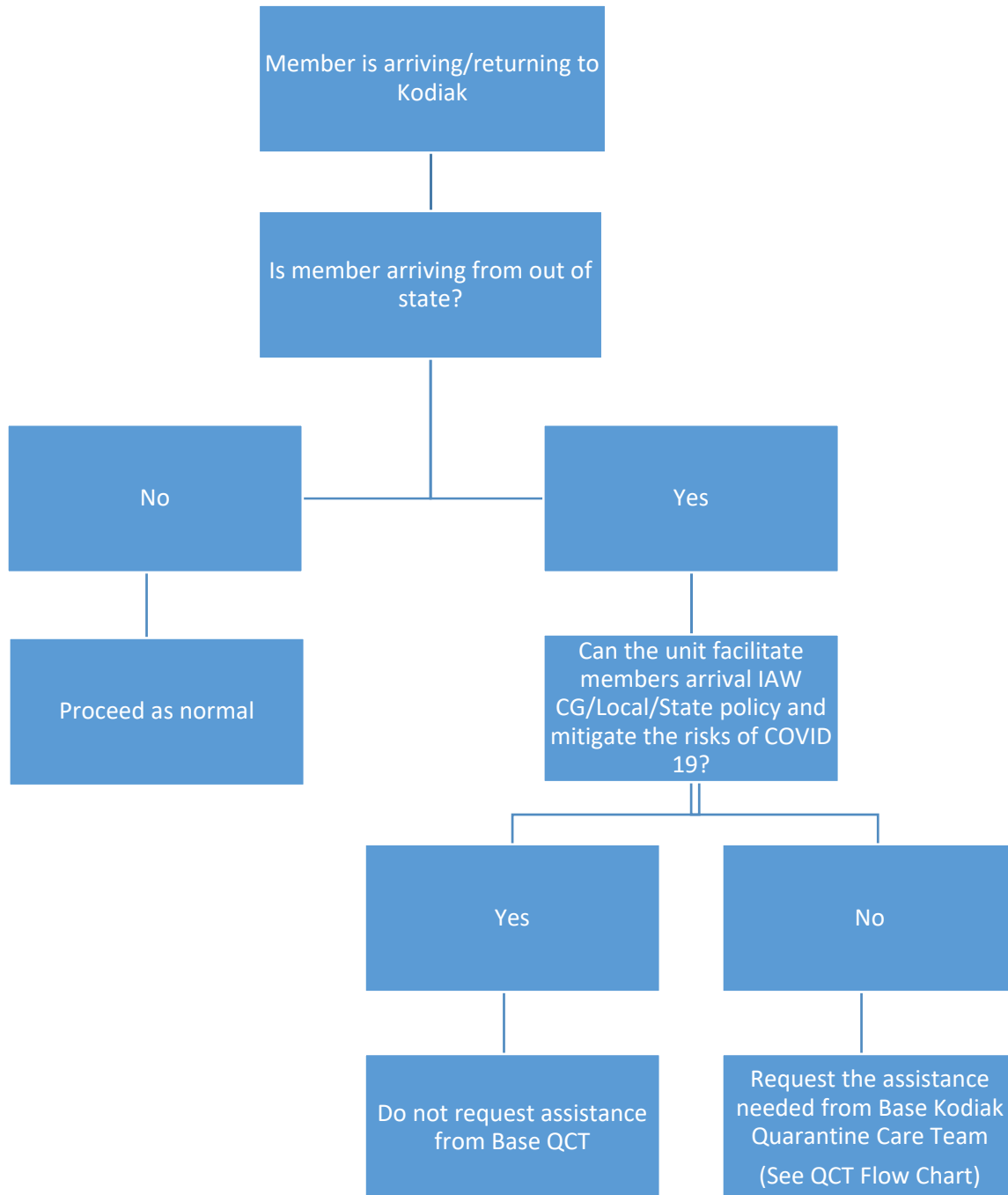
- **Units are responsible for arranging transportation, lodging, and meal delivery for all assigned personnel. Base Kodiak will provide support on a case-by-case basis under unique circumstances (i.e. while underway).**

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## Quarantine Care Flow Chart

Afloat Unit learns member will be arriving PCS (TDY/Leave/Other) to Kodiak and determines that assistance is needed from the Base Kodiak Quarantine Care Team. (See QCT Decision Matrix)

Unit Immediately sends an email to Base Quarantine Care email requesting the specific services needed (Airport pickup, Lodging, Food Delivery), along with the following info:

Arriving Member is added to Quarantine Care Tracker.

Unit receives acknowledgment via email from Pandemic Mitigation Team Members regarding arrival of Member. Unit also receives link to Base Kodiak COVID-19 website with vital information regarding quarantine process to be read by arriving member and their sponsor.

Airport Pickup, Lodging, Food Delivery Teams provide services requested to members listed on tracker IAW information and instructions provided on Base Kodiak COVID19 website.

Unit/Unit Sponsor/Unit COVID POC track members progress, provide updates, ensure medical quarantine requirements are met.

Member completes quarantine/isolation period.
