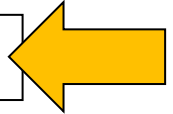

GREEN or LOW RISK- No or low level community Transmission in Kodiak.


AMBER or MEDIUM RISK- Moderate Transmission Risk in Kodiak.

RED or HIGH RISK- Community Transmission on Base Kodiak.
