YOU ARE NEVER VERY FAR FROM OUR THOUGHTS OR PRAYERS.

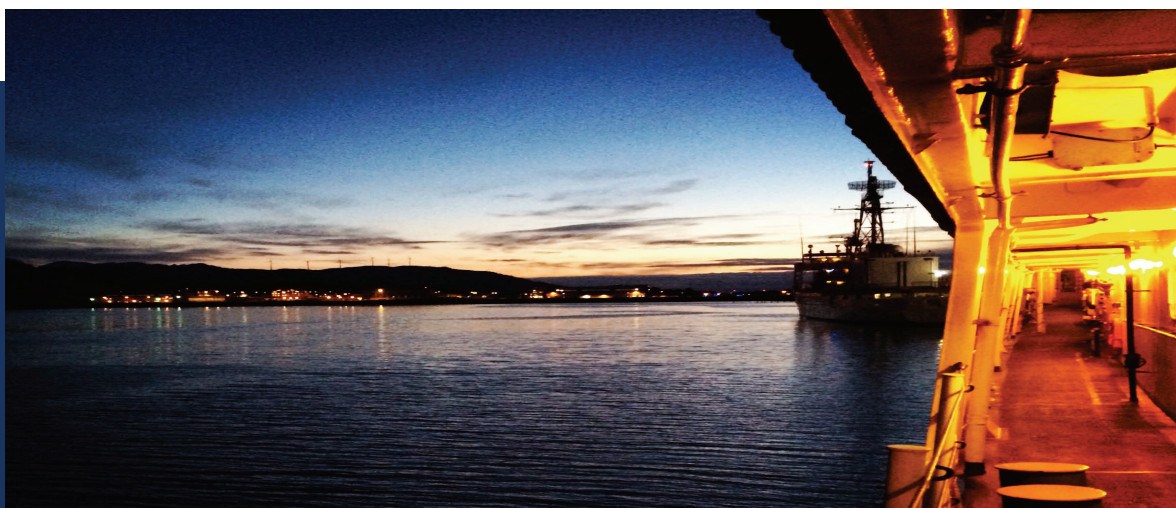
