



LIEUTENANT COMMANDER JARRETT S. PARKER

LCDR Jarrett Parker is from Boynton Beach, FL. He graduated from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy in 2006 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Operations Research and Computer Analysis. His first assignment was serving as Student Engineer Officer aboard the 378' CGC JARVIS home ported in Honolulu, HI. During this tour, he supervised three dry docks of the cutter and made one patrol in the bearing sea during the filming of the hit tv series, "Deadliest Catch". In 2008, LCDR Parker transferred to the USCG Research and Development Center in New London, CT as the Naval Engineering Subject Matter Expert. He developed the Biometric at Sea System, used simulation and modeling on a Fleet Mix Analysis Study of the effects of budget cuts on the entire Coast Guard with results presented to congress and he deployed as part of the response team to Deepwater Horizon. Afterwards in 2011, LT Parker was accepted into the Coast Guard Industrial Management Program and attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, NY earning a Master of Engineering degree in Systems Engineering & Technology Management. From 2012-16, he was the Industrial Manager of Industrial Production Facility Detroit and Industrial Production Detachment Sault Ste Marie in MI. He was responsible for planning & executing all the depot level maintenance in District 9 (Great Lakes) and deployed in response to Superstorm Sandy. Following that, he taught in the Department of Mathematics at the U.S. Coast Guard Academy for two years, surf club advisor, and was the summer Engineering Training Officer on the Tallship CGC EAGLE. In 2018, LCDR Parker transferred to Sector San Juan in Puerto Rico after Hurricanes Maria/Irma as the Engineer Officer, overseeing all naval engineering support on the island and led the recovery & long-term recap plan of the damaged shore facilities. LCDR Parker became a plank owner of Base San Juan in 2019 as the Facilities Engineer responsible for all civil engineering support in San Juan.

Currently, LCDR Parker has the duties of Supervisor of Coast Guard Base Detachment Borinquen in Aguadilla, Puerto Rico.

His awards include a CG Commendation Medal, three CG Achievement Medals, and numerous unit, team, and service awards.
