

Lieutenant Commander (LCDR) Avery L. Weston assumed the responsibilities as Executive Officer of U.S. Coast Guard Base San Juan in June of 2022, having just completed his tour as the Assistant Facilities Engineer at Coast Guard Yard, in Baltimore, Maryland.

LCDR Weston earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the Coast Guard Academy (High Honors) and a Masters of Science in Civil Engineering from Virginia Tech. He is a licensed Professional Engineer (P.E.) in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

LCDR Weston's Coast Guard experience includes serving on CGC *Healy* as a Student Engineer, Flight School and Shore Infrastructure Logistics Center. Onboard CGC *Healy*, LCDR Weston was member of the crew that provided 400 miles of close quarter ice breaking for the tanker vessel Renda to deliver critical fuel to Nome, Alaska – the first-ever delivery of fuel to an Arctic Alaska settlement via sea ice. At Flight School in Pensacola, FL LCDR Weston qualified in the Cessna-172 and the Joint Primary Pilot aircraft, the T-6B Texan II. At the Shore Infrastructure Logistics Center, LCDR Weston oversaw the execution of \$250 million annually for depot-level maintenance of facilities and was responsible for the life cycle management of the \$27 billion shore plant inventory. As the Assistant Facilities Engineer, LCDR Weston led the successful completion of the \$26M dry-dock expansion project to increase shipyard capacity by 30 percent.
