Captain Ben Davis assumed duties as Deputy, U.S. Coast Guard Director of Operational Logistics in April, 2019. The Director of Operational Logistics (DOL) ensures delivery of mission support logistics for Coast Guard operations during steady state and contingency response and for planned events of national significance and serves as field headquarters for the 16 Coast Guard Base commands. In addition, Captain Davis serves as the Chief, Office of Base Operations (DOL-3), directly supervising the Coast Guard's 16 Bases and 2 Base Detachments throughout the United States.



Prior to assuming the responsibilities as Deputy and DOL-3, he was the Commanding Officer of Coast Guard Base Miami Beach, FL, responsible for mission support activities that support Coast Guard operations by the Seventh Coast Guard District and its subordinate commands in the Southeast. Previous assignments include Commanding Officer of Civil Engineering Unit Miami, FL, Facility Engineer at the Telecommunication and Information Systems Command in Alexandria, VA, Chief of Construction at Civil Engineering Unit Cleveland, OH, Assistant Facilities Engineer at Support Center, Elizabeth City, NC, Port and Waterways Safety System Coordinator at Civil Engineering Unit Miami, FL. He also served two years as a Deck Watch Officer and First Lieutenant aboard the Coast Guard Cutter ESCAPE in Charleston, SC.

Captain Davis is a 1992 graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, earning a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering. In 1997 he attended the University of Illinois and earned a Master of Science degree in Civil Engineering. He is a registered Professional Engineer in the Commonwealth of Virginia and is certified as a Project Management Professional, a Facility Management Professional, and a DHS Acquisition Level II Program Manager and Level II Facilities Engineer.

Captain Davis' personal awards include two Coast Guard Meritorious Service Medals, four Coast Guard Commendation Medals, the Coast Guard Achievement Medal, the Commandant's Letter of Commendation, and various service and unit awards.
