Subj: PY23 SCHEDULE OF OFFICER PERSONNEL BOARDS AND PANELS

Ref: (a) Officer Accessions, Evaluations, and Promotions, COMDTINST M1000.3 (series)

- (b) Reserve Policy Manual, COMDTINST M1001.28 (series)
- (c) Guidance and Eligibility Criteria for Officer Personnel Boards and Panels, PSCINST 1401.1(series)
- (d) ALCGPSC 044/22 (2022 OER Submission and PY23 Officer Selection Boards)
- (e) Title 14, U.S. Code
- 1. <u>PURPOSE</u>. Publish convening dates for Active Duty Promotion List (ADPL) and Inactive Duty Promotion List (IDPL) officer personnel boards and panels for promotion year (PY) 2023, which occurs from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023.
- 2. <u>ACTION</u>. All Coast Guard unit commanders, commanding officers, officers-in-charge, deputy/assistant commandants, and chiefs of headquarters staff elements shall comply with the provisions of this Notice. Internet release is authorized.
- 3. <u>DIRECTIVES AFFECTED</u>. Promotion Year 2022 Schedule of Officer Personnel Boards and Panels, PSCNOTE 1401 is canceled on 30 June 2022.
- 4. <u>DISCLAIMER</u>. This guidance is not a substitute for applicable legal requirements, nor is it itself a rule. It is intended to provide operational guidance for Coast Guard personnel and is not intended to nor does it impose legally-binding requirements on any party outside the Coast Guard.
- 5. <u>IMPACT ASSESSMENT</u>. This Notice creates no new personnel resources, training, or funding requirements.
- 6. ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECT AND IMPACT CONSIDERATIONS.
 - a. The development of this Notice and the general policies contained within it have been thoroughly reviewed by the originating office and in conjunction with the Office of Environmental Management, and are categorically excluded (CE) under current USCG CE #33 from further environmental analysis, in accordance with Section 2.B.2 and Figure 2-1 of the National Environmental Policy Act Implementing procedures and Policy for Considering Environmental Impacts, COMDTINST M16475.1(series).
 - b. This Notice will not have any of the following: significant cumulative impacts on the human environment; substantial controversy or substantial change to existing environmental conditions;

or inconsistencies with any Federal, State, or local laws or administrative determinations relating to the environment.

7. <u>DISTRIBUTION</u>. No paper distribution will be made of this Notice. An electronic version will be located on the following Commander CG Personnel Service Center Portal site: https://cglink.uscg.mil/e0fbceaf.

8. RELATED DIRECTIVES.

- a. Chapters 1, 3, 6, and 7 of reference (a) contain regulations governing the various officer personnel boards and panels.
- b. Reference (b) contains regulations specific to reserve officer personnel boards and panels.
- c. Reference (c) contains guidance to officers eligible for consideration by a selection/retention board or panel. It also contains the screening and eligibility criteria for officer personnel panels.

9. GENERAL GUIDANCE FOR ALL OFFICERS.

- a. <u>Submitting Performance Evaluations</u>. Submit Officer Evaluation Reports (OERs) in accordance with Chapter 5 of reference (a) to ensure selection boards and panels have complete, up-to-date information. Under no circumstances will those officers above the zone, or who are projected to be in the zone for promotion, delay their regular annual or semiannual OER past the scheduled due date. For this purpose, estimated zones were announced in reference (d). The schedule of boards and panels was developed to correspond as closely as possible with the OER submission schedule.
- b. <u>Commanding Officers of Reserve Active Status Officers</u>. Commanding officers of officers serving in the Ready Reserve (Selected Reserve (SELRES)), Individual Ready Reserve (IRR), and Standby Reserve (Active Status List (ASL)) must:
 - (1) Ensure all active status officers are aware of the contents of this Notice.
 - (2) Provide a copy of the All Coast Guard Reserve (ALCGRSV) message announcing selection zones to each officer being considered by a selection or retention board.
- 10. <u>ADPL AND IDPL PROMOTION BOARD ZONES AND CONVENING DATES</u>. This Notice, which is further amplified by appropriate message traffic, serves as the official notification required by Section 2108 of reference (e). Future messages may announce changes to enclosures (1) and (2). Commander, PSC is authorized to delay or reschedule the listed boards and panels as Service needs dictate.
- 11. <u>ADPL SENIOR EDUCATION AND FELLOWSHIP PANEL (SEFP)</u>. The SEFP will select candidates for senior fellowships, Senior Service School (SSS), and senior advanced education programs. This Panel will be divided into two phases: Phase I will select an O-6 officer for the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR) fellowship, while Phase II will cover the O-5 programs.

- a. <u>Council on Foreign Relations Fellowships</u>. SEFP Phase I will consider all tour complete Captains who request consideration for selection. PSC-OPM will release an ALCGOFF outlining instructions to this fellowship in May.
- b. <u>SSS, Sloan Fellowship and MIT-SDM</u>. The SEFP Phase II will consider tour complete O-5 and O-5 selects who request consideration for selection. An ALCGOFF will be released by PSC-OPM outlining the instructions and specific criteria by which officers can apply for the respective War Colleges and fellowship opportunities.
- 12. <u>RESERVE SENIOR EDUCATION AND FELLOWSHIP PANEL (SEFP)</u>. The Reserve SEFP will select candidates for senior fellowships and advanced education programs. This Panel will select primary and alternate candidates to attend the Joint Combined Warfighting School Hybrid and primary and alternate candidates to attend Reserve Components National Security Course. Convening date announcements and application guidance for specific SEFP courses will be provided via separate ALCGRSV message traffic.
- 13. <u>RECORDS MANAGEMENT</u>. This Notice has been thoroughly reviewed during the directives clearance process, and it has been determined there are no further records scheduling requirements, in accordance with Federal Records Act, 44 U.S.C. 3101 et seq., NARA requirements, and Information and Life Cycle Management Manual, COMDTINST M5212.12 (series). This policy does not have any significant or substantial change to existing records management requirements.

- 2. The number of officers included in an ADPL promotion zone is calculated in a two-step process. First, the number of officers to be selected is determined based on projected vacancies. Second, the actual zone sizes are determined by establishing the opportunity of selection for each grade.
- 3. Submit applications to PSC-OPM via the process outlined in the solicitation message.
- 4. A message will announce the number to be selected and the criteria.
- 5. A decision to hold this board/panel will be determined at a later date.
- 6. Reserve officers whose active duty agreements expire during the indicated period and who do not apply will be released when their Extended Active Duty (EAD) Agreement expires.
- 7. Date tentative; refer to ALCOAST/ALCGPSC Announcement Message for actual convening date.
- 8. Refer to ref (e) for screening criteria and eligibility requirements.
